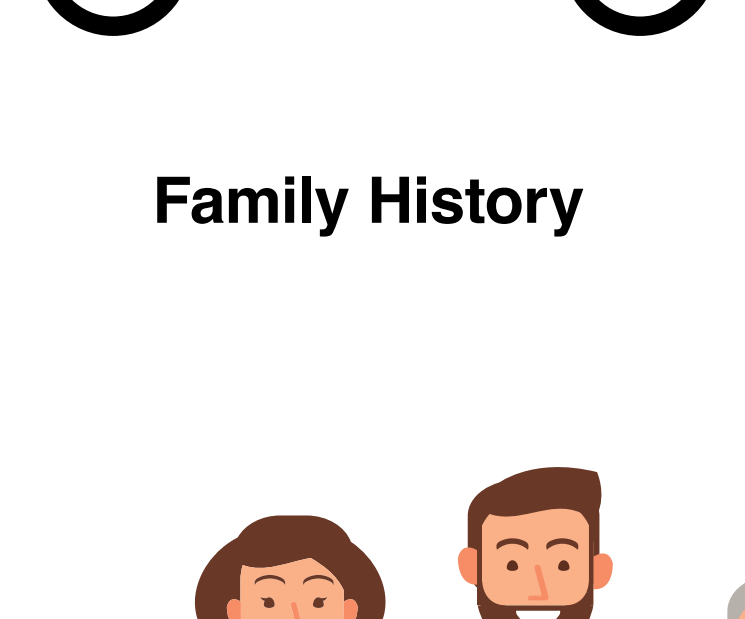

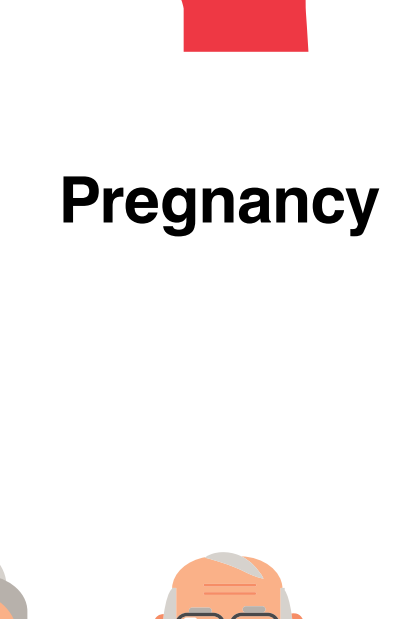

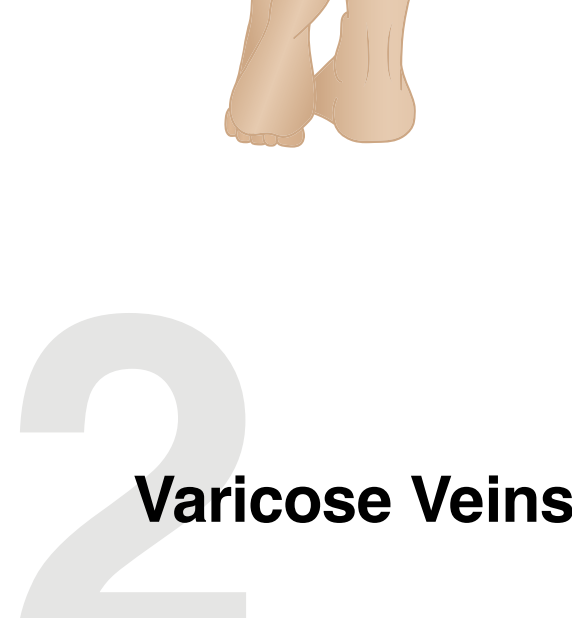

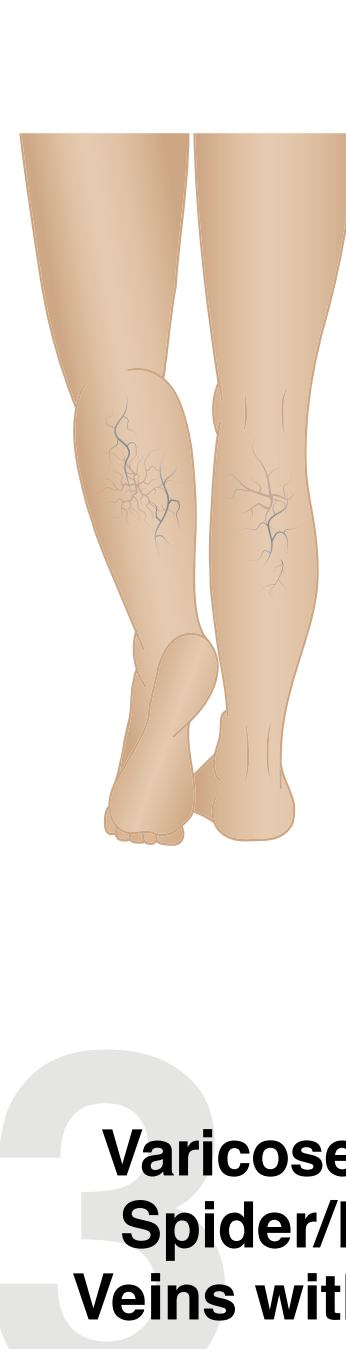

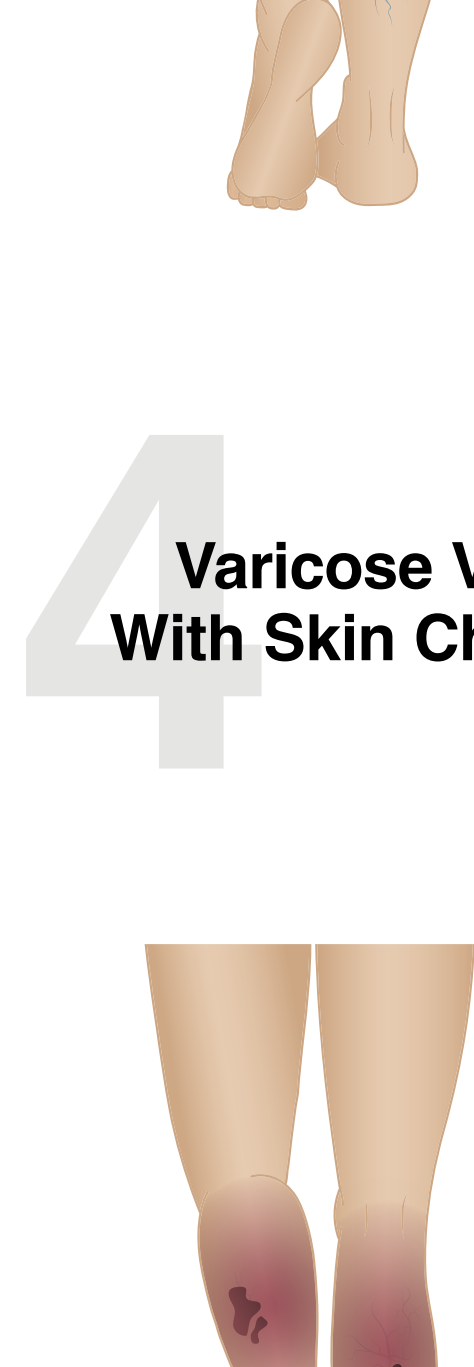
1 Spider and Reticular Veins

3 Varicose Veins or Spider/Reticular Veins with Swelling



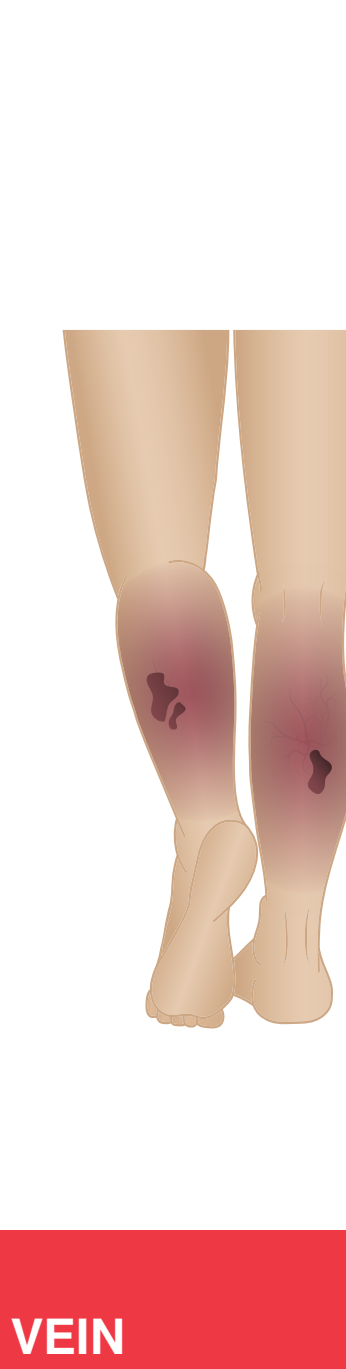
4 Varicose Veins With Skin Changes



5 Varicose Veins With Healed Ulcers

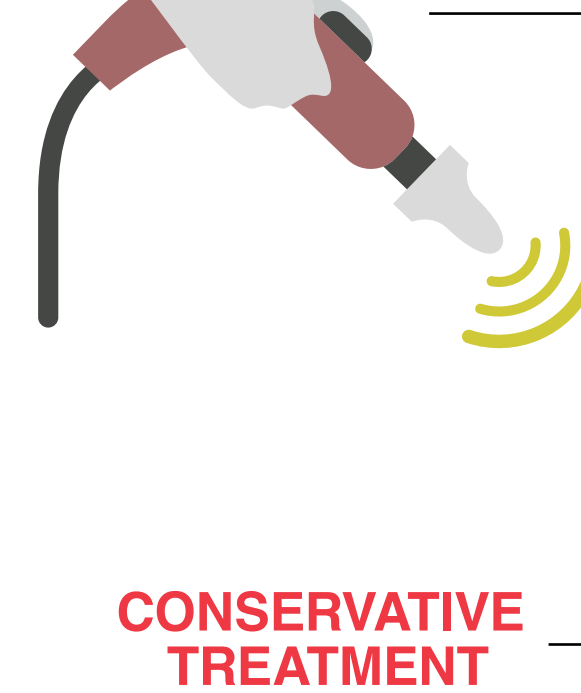


6 Varicose Veins With Ulcers

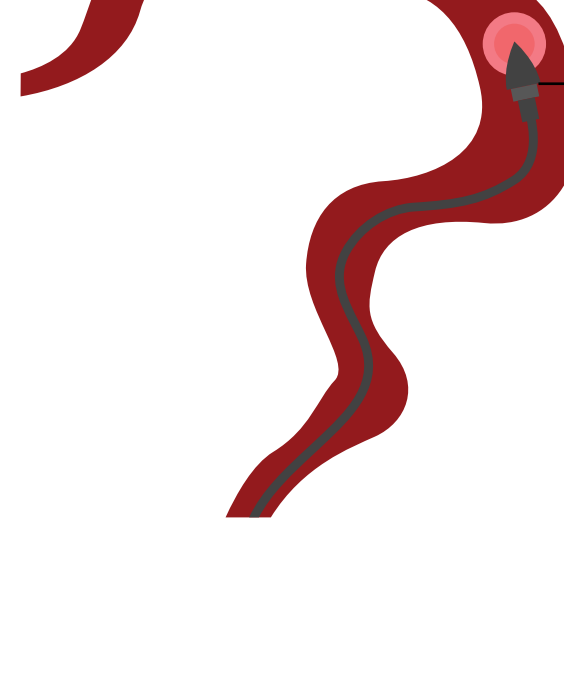

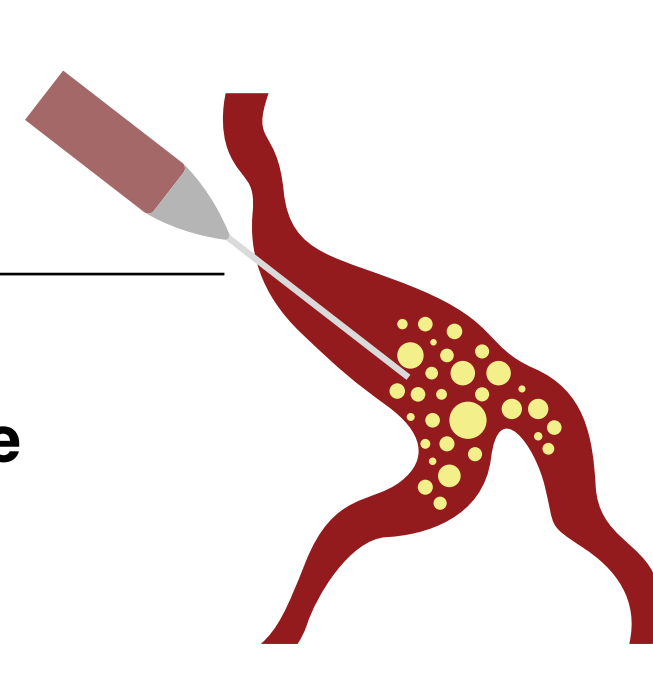

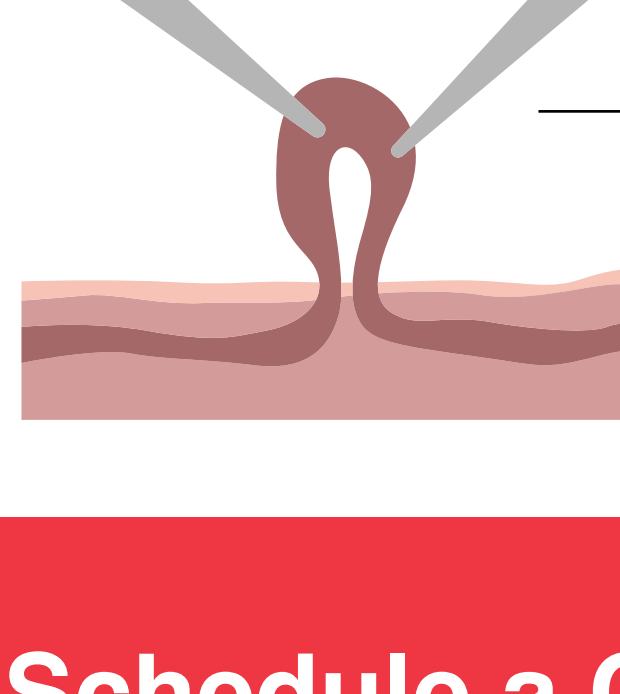
